A recent IMF study argues that natural resource abundance creates opportunities for corrupt profit-seeking behaviour and serves as one important variable in determining a country's level of corruption. On May 14 – 15, members of the Canadian energy and resource sectors and those servicing such sectors (i.e., lawyers, accountants, consultants), will gather at The Banff Centre for Management to discuss challenges presented by and solutions to corruption in the international marketplace. Some questions to be addressed include: Do you know whom you are doing business with? Whom can you trust? How do you balance regulation vs. legal liability? Is voluntary regulation enough? How do you operate legally in an environment without laws? How are challenges for juniors different from those for multinationals? What are the ethical and corruption challenges for the Canadian resource sector within a society in socio-political transformation? What impact does corruption have on human rights? What practical strategies can be put in place to deal with corruption in the field? We invite you to contribute your thoughts and recommendations toward a follow-up agenda for TI-Canada.
